3. Chair's Report

Cllr. Julie Knowles presented her report with regard to the activities of the Parish Council during 2024/25. She thanked everyone for their support throughout the year including the Vice-Chair, the other parish councillors, her husband, the Clerk and the two W&FC councillors, who had between them attended every meeting.
